Glossary

External Distance Learning - way of learning and teaching that does not require students' presence in the classroom; external distance learning uses digital online tools to deliver the content and do exercises.

e-Learning System - an educational platform that takes place over the Internet and manages e-learning activities.

Synchronous learning - a method of online learning that requires students' and teacher's presence in the lesson at the same time

Asynchronous learning - a method of learning that does not require students' and teacher's presence in the lesson at the same time; students do their tasks at a convenient time for them.

Collaborative tools - apps, software programs or platforms that help people work together more efficiently.
