Key Features:	 Management is done by creating boards and cards (in the free version 10 boards and an unlimited number of cards are possible) Integration with apps Reminders and notifications via email
Strengths of the technology	 Unlimited members in the free version Beautiful and clear layout Available in more than 20 languages Great possibility of personalizing the workspace ("drag and drop")
Weakness of the technology	 In the free version only one app can be integrated with one board

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	 Each board can be different – students can get lost if every teacher makes a different board
Why using in education?	 Fosters creativity Possibility to organize the tasks, shows the progress Sends reminders
Main interface issues	Boards and cards – they can be organized in many ways (the user chooses)
